

GIVING SECURITIES TO ST. ALBANS SCHOOL

Thank you for your interest in making a gift of securities to St. Albans School. St. Albans is a legal entity of The Protestant Episcopal Cathedral Foundation (**PECF**). All gifts of securities intended for the School must be directed to the PECF, which, upon receipt, credits them to STA.

Broker-Assisted Electronic Transfers: The easiest, fastest, and safest way to give appreciated securities held in "street name" for you by a broker or bank.

This requires a signed letter from the donor/s to the broker or bank that:

- 1. Identifies the shares (either a specific number or a target dollar total) to be transferred to "The Protestant Episcopal Cathedral Foundation for the benefit of St. Albans School."
- 2. Explains how the School should allocate the gift (for example: Annual Giving, The STRIVE Campaign, or for a specific area such as financial aid, etc).
- 3. Provides all below information on the PECF's brokerage account:
 - a. Donor identification
 - b. PECF beneficiary institution (in this case, St. Albans School)
 - c. The objective/s to be funded

Most importantly, to ensure prompt and accurate processing of the transfer, please communicate the donor's intentions by mailing, faxing, or e-mailing a copy of the signed letter to the designated representatives at PECF Treasury and the St. Albans Development Offices.
